Articles of Incorporation of South Texas Peacock Military Academy

County of Bexar) (KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Wesley Peacock, Jr., Fred J. Johnston, Donald Wing Peacock and E.B. Ramsdell, all of whom are residents and citizens of the State of Texas, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a private corporation under the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth:

I.

The name of this corporation is the South Texas Peacock Military Academy.

II.

The purposes for which the South Texas Peacock Military Academy is formed are:

- (1) To promote, foster, and encourage the mental, moral, and physical development, training and education of boys and young men; to teach a through and complete collegiate course and military tactics;
- (2) To purchase, lease and acquire lands, buildings, equipment, supplies and other property, real or personal, which may be necessary, suitable or proper in carrying on the business of this corporation;
- (3) To borrow money for any corporate purpose upon any assets of the corporation; and to execute and endorse any and all commercial papers or other written obligations of the corporation in connection with any of the above mentioned activities;
- (4) To employ teachers, instructors and other necessary help and assistance as may be proper and necessary; and
- (5) To do each and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the successful carrying out of the purposes mentioned herein-above, or either of them.

III.

The place where the principal business of the South Texas Peacock Military Academy will be transacted is in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas.

IV.

The term for which the South Texas Peacock Military Academy is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of incorporation.

V.

The number of directors shall be four (4) and their names and post-office addresses are as follows:
