SUBJECT: Senior Week Activities and Privileges

TO: Members of the Graduating Class of 1962.

Senior Week begins officially at 12:00 noon, Friday, 18 May 1962. Attached hereto is an Activity Calendar for Senior Week. The following is published for the information and guidance of all concerned, with a copy sent to your parents.

Automobiles. Seniors are permitted to keep cars at the Academy during Senior Week. They will register same with the Commandant and keep the keys at the office when not on permit. Cars will not be driven or moved from the prescribed parking place except when authorized or when the owner is on permit to leave the campus. Rules for riding in cars will be the same as prescribed in the Cadet Handbook (Page 14), except that Seniors may ride in other Seniors' cars without permission. At no time, will there be more than six (6) people in one car, including dates.

Caution: Do not "loan" your car to another cadet, and do not let another cadet drive your car without authority from the Commandant, and do not take your car outside the "Greater San Antonio" area without specific authority from the Superintendent or Commandant. Those seniors who are to have cars during the entire Senior Week should arrange with their parents to have their car delivered to the Academy Friday, May 18, between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm, so they will be available for the Junior-Senior Prom that night. Special permits to go home for the purpose of getting your car will not be granted. If parents wish, they may deliver your car to San Antonio prior to May 18, store it in a downtown garage, and arrange for you to obtain delivery of it on May 18. In cases of this kind, the Commandant should be notified of the arrangements made.

Special Privileges. Beginning today (May 1), Seniors may study in their quarters during Night Study Hall, providing they are passing in all subjects with no grade below "C", and comply with the same rules required of Honor Roll students permitted to study in quarters. During "Senior Week" beginning at 12:00 noon, Friday, 18 May 1962, all Seniors have the privilege of studying in their quarters during NSH, and may study in their quarters or on the campus during their library periods during the day. Special drug store permits and swimming pool privileges during Senior Week will be announced later.

Advice. You have only a few days left before graduation - the final result of 12 years of schooling and much sacrifice on the part of your parents. Many of you have reached high places of honor on the Student Council, as Cadet Officers or Non-Commissioned Officers, etc. These final few days are the real test of your worth and moral character, and you must be on your best behavior and observe all rules of the Academy at all times. Do not take a single chance! For the sake of your parents, if no other reason, you should graduate with the highest possible honors.
